



Lesson Plan –Pollinator Word Search

To introduce students to the diverse array of pollinators in their communities.

Materials Needed:

Copies of **Pollinator Word Search worksheet**

Time:

One science class period of about 30 minutes

Procedure:

- The Pollinator Word Search activity would be a fun introduction to a series of lesson plans about the important role of bees and other pollinators to the sustainability of the environment.
- The educator or group leader will tell students that the word list in the Pollinator Word Search contains the names of many types of pollinators and offers clues to the ways that we benefit from their work in nature.

Outcome/Result:

Students will become familiar with vocabulary pertaining to pollinators and their impact on the environment.
